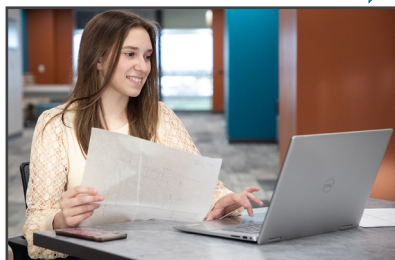


CREDIT TRANSFER

Wisconsin's 16 technical colleges often serve as an entry point for students with four-year degree aspirations. Lesser known is that they also provide valuable options for four-year students seeking to transfer to a technical college. Because receiving institutions maintain student records, this report's primary focus is on students who transferred credits to one of Wisconsin's 16 technical colleges, highlighting students' mobility.

39% TRANSFERRED FROM A UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN (UW) SYSTEM INSTITUTION

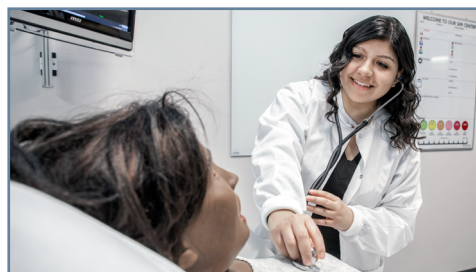
30% TRANSFERRED FROM A COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY OUTSIDE OF WISCONSIN
